2009 Mississippi Collegiate Art Competition

Lewis Art Gallery at Millsaps College

February 21 to March 19, 2009

ELIGIBILITY: Four-year college and university students (undergraduate and graduate) who are/were currently enrolled within the last 12 months in a degree granting program in the state of Mississippi are eligible to enter the competition. Students are not required to be art majors. Work produced after the 2008 Mississippi Collegiate Art competition by graduating seniors (December 2008, May 2008, Summer 2008) are also eligible. All submitted work must be created during the student's time of enrollment at the submitting school. Works previously exhibited in the Mississippi Collegiate Art Competition are not eligible.

JUROR: An out-of-state university professor, currently teaching studio art classes who is also an actively producing artist with no current or former Mississippi affiliations is selected each year to jury the competition. The juror will select all awards. The decision of the juror is final.

JUROR FOR THE 2009 COMPETITION: MICHAEL CRESPO, Professor of Painting and Drawing, Louisiana State University

AWARDS: BEST OF SHOW, 3 AWARDS OF EXCELLENCE , and a JUROR'S AWARD DESIGNATING SUPERIOR ACHIEVEMENT IN EACH MEDIA. Awards will be presented at the discretion of the juror and may not necessarily be issued in each media.

ENTRY: Digital images only. Entries must be RGB JPEG with no compression or RGB TIFF files submitted on a CD or DVD. Files should be 72dpi with a maximum pixel length of 1024. Schools please group all digital entries on one CD or DVD with folders separating each category of media. All digital entries must be labeled with proper institution *abbreviation, category, artist's last name, entry number and unique title designation. *Millsaps College - MC and Mississippi College - MSC . All works must have unique titles. Anything untitled should read: Untitled1, Untitled2, Untitled3, ect. (Example: MSU_PTG_JONES_4_Untitled2.jpg) MSU is the institutional designation, PTG is the category, 4 is the sequential order of entry, and Untitled2 is the unique title. Because digital file names have limited spaces, names and titles may also be abbreviated. Include on the CD or DVD a folder with an EXCEL list of the artist full names and complete titles corresponding with the sequentially numbered entries. If files cannot be opened or are incorrectly labeled, entries will be rejected.

ALL FINE ART MEDIA: (CA) CLAY ARTS, (CI) COMPUTER IMAGING, (D) DESIGN, (DR) DRAWING, (FA) FIBER ARTS, (GA) GLASS ARTS. (MA) METAL ARTS, (MM) MIXED MEDIA, (PTG) PAINTING, (PH) PHOTOGRAPHY, (PR) PRINTMAKING, (S) SCULPTURE.

SIZE REQUIREMENTS: Accepted works should be of a dimension that will allow for proper handling and display by the host museum.
(No work may exceed 8 feet in any direction and 200 pounds in weight)

ENTRY FEE: A non-refundable fee of \$5.00 for one to three entries will be charged. A fee of \$3.00 for each additional entry will be charged with no limit as to the total number of entries per artist. A single money order from each school made payable to the Millsaps College Department of Art should be used. (SCHOOLS - PLEASE DO NOT SEND INDIVIDUAL STUDENT CHECKS OR CASH).

PRESENTATION: All accepted art works must be presented in a professional manner, suitably framed and ready for hanging. Three-dimensional pieces must be assembled and ready for exhibition. If a work requires special installation, the artist is responsible for providing the appropriate apparatus. Each school competition coordinator is responsible for the final presentation. Coordinators include your name, telephone, E-Mail, and Fax.

SALES: Sales of accepted entries will be encouraged. The host museum will retain a commission of 25 percent.

LIABILITY: Every possible precaution will be taken in the handling, exhibiting, and storage of all accepted entries, but the museum cannot assume responsibility for the loss or damage of art work or slides. Sending an entry to this competition will constitute agreement with all conditions in this prospectus.

ACCEPTED ENTRIES: All accepted work must remain for the shows duration. A catalog listing the accepted artists and a list of the award winners will be printed and mailed to all participating schools. The host museum reserves the right to refuse any work deemed not creditable to the exhibition.
